#### President's Update

## VP/Director Social Update

- NCC presents a Halloween Haunt event (October 21st-October 31st).

- The ticket price for New College students will be \$30
- The ticket price for students not affiliated with New College will be \$48
- Transportation cost is not covered for Canada's Wonderland Halloween Haunt event.
- The Montreal trip was an overall success except for one inconvenience, Best Western Hotel blamed New College for property damage and charged for it.
- NCC believes the property was damaged prior to our stay and believes Best Western Hotel staff are being uncooperative and creating unnecessary conflict.
- Maria is negotiating with Best Western Hotel to refund the charge for damaged property.
- Maria approached "Risk at york" to gain knowledge for the legal actions council members can take on behalf of New College in regards to the issue that arose at Best Western Hotel in Montreal during the trip and is still waiting for their response.
- Maria attended data analytics event

- NCC will be organising Canada's Wonderland Halloween Haunt event on its own and will directly contact Canada's wonderland for tickets instead of relying on YFS as they proposed a lot of conditions and were basically making the whole process inconvenient instead of helping.
- The winners of mini games during welcome week have received gift cards as prizes.
- Maria is not in favour of the pumpkin carving event for Halloween initiated by Tiarah. She believes NC already has Halloween Haunt at Canada's Wonderland as well as Cross college party during halloween week and pumpkin Carving would be unnecessary and require extra budget.
- Maria proposes a new time for bi-weekly meetings as it interferes during class time for a lot of council members.
- Propane tank in the NC office needs to be disposed of as it is a hazard.
- The donations collected need to be properly distributed among the ones in need.
